

Outside Visitor Expectations

1. Remain in your car on arrival and call 603-399-4912 from your vehicle. (Pull up to the new main entrance under the awning).
2. You will be screened prior to exiting your car, including a temperature check. If you do not have your own mask, we will provide one.
3. Use hand sanitizer at the start and end of your visit and any time you touch your mask or face.
4. You will be required to stay 6 feet from your loved one.
5. No touching will be allowed.
6. Sharing food is not allowed (i.e.- bag of chips).
7. Your visit will be monitored for infection prevention measures, while respecting your right to a private visit.
8. We apologize, but allowing you inside to use bathrooms is not currently permissible - please plan accordingly.
9. After leaving our facility, monitor yourself for signs and symptoms of Covid-19 for the next 14 days. You should be monitoring for:
 - a. Sore throat, runny nose, nasal congestion
 - b. New GI symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)
 - c. Shortness of breath or any new respiratory illness
 - d. New, dry cough
 - e. Fever (temperature greater than 100°F)
 - f. Loss of taste or smell
 - g. General feeling of illness, muscle aches, chills, severe fatigue

If you note any of these symptoms within 2 days of your visit, please contact Maplewood immediately at 603-399-4912 and let us know the date of your visit, the resident and staff you had contact with and which area of the facility you visited.
